

**MINUTES OF THE RIFLE AND PISTOL RANGE  
BOARD OF MANAGEMENT MEETING  
JANUARY 25, 2006**

Board members present: Freddy Haltom, Joe Compton, John Krenik, Mike Hagan and Don Robinett.

Club members present:

1. Freddy brought up that Tony and he had discussed that all current projects needed to be finished before any new projects were considered. The list of current unfinished projects are, Perimeter signs, Berm work on silhouette range, 25 yard rail on silhouette range, Fence project, Bullseye range repair, East end canopy, and Range B canopy.
2. The occasional exceptions to the range rules were discussed. We will continue to look at these and made a final decision in the February meeting.
3. Safety concerns with the 500 yard target on range B were discussed again as were they in the July 2005 and December 2005 board meetings. It was decided on a majority vote to restrict access past the 300 yard berm by blocking the road in some fashion.
4. Discussion on what to do with the steel targets on Range B was started, with the decision to try a new type of target and remove the old targets for the time being. It was decided to purchase a 12" swinging target like the 3 Gun shooters use. We will put this target up and see how it does before making further plans
5. Joe Compton reported on the bids for the pistol range patio cover and the range B cover repairs. The board approved Joe to proceed with the projects with the contractors he has considered good for each project.
6. Joe Compton made a proposal to replace the range B electrical wiring at the appropriate time. It was voted on and approved to do so.
