

**MINUTES OF THE RIFLE AND PISTOL RANGE  
BOARD OF MANAGEMENT MEETING  
MARCH 25, 2006**

Board members present: Freddy Haltom, Joe Basham, Joe Compton, John Krenik and Bill Cooke.

Club members present: Tony Dilley, Brian Hendershot, Rick Pierce and Johnny Morgan

1. Freddy reported on the missing caliche. It turns out that the contractor repairing the roads on the Crawford property got dirt from the wrong pit. J.D. Crawford offered to forward the money he was paid for dirt to MSA. Approx. \$250
2. A report was given on the progress of the archery range. The range work is in progress to have the first match either in May or June on the new range.
3. The clearing of trees was mentioned as completed during the range care day by Johnny Morgan and Deon Christensen. We are now ready to start moving the junk pile to make the range cleaner looking, and make room for the new picnic area. The removal of dead trees and the planting of new trees was discussed. Each board member will make inquiries to the kind of trees to be purchased.
4. The use of range D was discussed, and the possibility of making it a high powered rifle range. All of the directors were in favor of making a more versatile range out of the current Black Powder only range. The exact lay out of the range will be determined by the cooperative effort of the board before a definite decision is made.
5. The discussion was continued on the removal of hard mounted steel targets as per NRA range inspector instructions. The work on the 25 yard rail on the silhouette range has begun. A short section was done by Tony Dilley to see if the design will work sufficiently before ordering more steel materials. It was agreed on by the board to consult Don Robinnet (Big Bore Pistol silhouette match director) on further alterations on the Silhouette range. John Krenik and Tony Dilley volunteered to get with Don on his suggestions.
