

**MINUTES OF THE RIFLE AND PISTOL RANGE  
BOARD OF MANAGEMENT MEETING  
JUNE 24, 2006**

Board members present: Freddy Haltom, Joe Basham, Joe Compton, John Krenik and Bill Cooke.

Club members present: Fran Compton.

1. The dead tree removal was discussed. It was decided that volunteer help would be recruited to remove said trees.
2. The tank remodel was discussed. The word was put out to look for a contractor. A contractor is needed to do the construction on the new welding and storage building.
3. Discussion on the possibility of purchasing a riding lawn mower for lighter mowing to be done by persons not capable of running the tractor. This project was put on hold for the time being.
4. The NRA range safety officer program was brought up again and what needed to be done to get it going.
5. The new competition sign in sheet was presented and approved to be implemented immediately. All persons on the range including competitors will be signed in on a form to be turned in to the rifle range officer.
6. Range D rules were reviewed with the addition of reconnecting the buzzer system to be controlled by the silhouette range. This will shut down shooting on range D while target set up is done on Range C. This may only be a temporary safety fix, until other options are considered.
7. A report was given on the trespassers on the rifle range and the two criminal trespass warnings that were issued. This matter will be taken to the general board meeting in August to vote on permanently banning these individuals from club membership and the property.
8. The presentation of a project to rewire the silhouette range was presented by Joe Compton. There are some ongoing problems with the wiring. It was voted on and approved to properly rewire the electrical on the silhouette range as soon as possible.
9. Bill Cooke brought up a suggestion to create a parking area just north of the clubhouse with an entrance off the entry road. All were in agreement that it would benefit orientation parking as well as other functions.
10. A report was given on the progress of painting on the range. Joe Compton will be looking for a person to do painting at the pay rate of \$8 per hour.
