

Midland Shooters Association regular quarterly board meeting

Meeting was called to order by Rick Pierce at 7:20 p.m.

The minutes of the May 16, 2006 meeting were submitted and approved with corrections.

Paul Brown presented the treasurer's report.

Joe Compton gave an update on recent range renovations including electrical work on Range B and the east restroom. He also noted that he will get volunteers to take down the old sheet metal on the Bullseye Range.

Motion was passed to hold a "Swap Fest/Gun Show" on the afternoon of September 17th. Members can offer firearms and related items for sale and the public is invited to attend.

Joe Compton made the following motion:

In order to expand and improve the general level of safety at the MSA Rifle & Pistol Range, and to insure that Midland Shooters Association members receive the maximum value for their investment in MSA, I move that MSA contract with Freddy Haltom, for the sum of \$1500 per month beginning September 1, 2006 and ending August 31, 2007, for him to carry out the following duties under the general direction of the MSA Rifle & Pistol Board, with Mr. Haltom qualifying as an independent contractor in accordance with state and federal requirements and conducting his duties as such:

- Oversee range safety planning and enforcement
- Organize and supervise an NRA Range Safety Officer program to assist him with range safety
- Evaluate the ranges and facilities and report findings to each Rifle & Pistol Board meeting
- Expedite range development projects and special events
- Coordinate with the MSA treasurer to establish and maintain inventory of MSA Rifle & Pistol Range assets
- Assist match directors and help coordinate development of new shooting programs.

After discussion, the motion passed.

Joe Compton moved that August 27, 2006 be Sandra Calhoun's last day as weekend range attendant. After discussion, the motion passed.
