

**MINUTES OF THE RIFLE AND PISTOL RANGE  
BOARD OF MANAGEMENT MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 23, 2006**

Board members present: Freddy Haltom, Joe Compton, John Krenik and Bill Cooke.

Club members present: Rick Pierce, Bill Perry, Pete Campbell and Howard Scott.

1. A proposal was made by Bill Cooke to consider the purchase of a riding lawn mower for close in work around houses and firing lines. After some discussion John Krenik seconded the proposal with a unanimous vote in favor of the purchase. A \$1200 amount was approved for the mower.
2. The proposal was brought up by Freddy Haltom to provide some concession stand items in the form of chips and crackers to be available on an honor system in the clubhouse. It was approved to spend a budget of \$50 for said items.
3. The proposal to create a youth archery course on the north east corner of the rifle range property was brought up by Freddy Haltom. The match dates for youth archery would be first Sundays at 3pm. This project was unanimously approved. No ranges will need to be closed for the youth archery match.
4. The issue of the dead trees was again discussed. John Krenik volunteered the High Power group to remove the three trees ASAP.
5. The issue of membership cards for 18 – 20 year olds under the family membership was discussed. It was decided that the ruling would be as follows: Any unmarried 18-20 year old person qualifying under the (within the household family membership), shall upon request, receive a membership card providing they have attended a range orientation, filled out an application showing that the main card holder is responsible for their actions, and that they cannot have guests.
6. It was approved to remove the clubhouse flooring and stain the concrete with a budgeted amount of \$300.
7. The purchase of a 10 mph speed limit sign for the west end of the range was approved with the budgeted amount of \$100.
