

**MINUTES OF THE RIFLE AND PISTOL RANGE  
BOARD OF MANAGEMENT MEETING  
OCTOBER 29, 2006**

1. Discussion on the decision to remodeling and use the steel tank as a storage garage was revisited, with the suggestion to suspend this project in favor of disposing of the tank and use the money to go toward a new building instead. John Krenik made the motion to do so, seconded by Bill Cooke and was unanimously approved
2. A proposal was made to make an exception to the sunrise to sunset firing rule. The exception was to extend the firing time to dark for Concealed handgun classes during the winter months November through February. Joe Compton made the motion, seconded by John Krenik and the vote was unanimous.
3. For discussion and thought only, the idea of a practical shooting discipline shoot house was brought up. Some discussion took place with the charge to research the issue further for later consideration.
4. The issue of the septic tank and sewer system on the east end restroom was brought up with the decision to be made for what to do about the improperly installed septic system by Ken's Plumbing. When installed the tank was crushed some and the drain field was disconnected from the tank. Wooten septic company repaired the system as good as possible with some recommendations. After some research and recommendations it was decided that since the system ran four years as is, with no drain field connected, we voted to let it run as is and do the repairs when the system fails.
5. Pete Campbell brought up the possible need for emergency contact information sign to be posted at major areas of the range. Pete said he would come up with the information that needed to be on the sign.
