

**MINUTES OF THE RIFLE AND PISTOL RANGE
BOARD OF MANAGEMENT MEETING
JANUARY 27, 2007**

1. A brochure that is no longer in publication was attained by Freddy Haltom from the Texas Dept. of Health on lead dust hazards. It was presented to the board for review for distribution to club members. After review Joe Compton made a motion to distribute the information to all new club members at the range orientations and any club member upon request and place the information on the web site. John Krenik seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
2. The new target backers were discussed. John Krenik and John Drissel came up with the idea to make target backers out of wire mesh instead of celotex for extended life and shot placement visibility. There are currently test backers on the 200 yard range and in one pistol bay. We will increase the amount of wire backers to continue testing.
3. The idea of a 700 yard berm on range D was brought up and discussed. This would extend the distance available to be shot with rifles on range D. There was no determination on what would be done and the issue was tabled for further study.
4. The process of evaluating the current rifle and pistol range rules was begun. Any rules changes or rewording will become effective September 1, 2007
