

**MINUTES OF THE RIFLE AND PISTOL RANGE
BOARD OF MANAGEMENT MEETING
MARCH 24, 2007**

1. At the February annual meeting, additional money was approved for the Bullseye Range remodel project.
2. It was reported that due to timing issues and by email vote, Joe Compton was nominated and approved as project manager. Joe gave a report on the project.
3. At the annual meeting, money for the new storage and tractor building was approved.
4. John Krenik was nominated and approved as project manager. John gave a report on the project.
5. At the annual meeting, the electronic gate for the rifle range was approved.
6. Rick Pierce was nominated and approved as project manager. Rick gave a report on the project. After some discussion a committee of Rick's choosing was to investigate the many ideas of operation for the gate.
7. Rick Pierce gave a report on the telephone vote and approval of the purchase of 400 bowling pins for special events. Cost of the pins was \$400.
8. In continuation of rule changes for the next membership year, Rule #2 under safety rule for all ranges was divided and was approved to read: 2. Take your firearm to and from the firing line only when everyone is safely behind the firing line and the range has been cleared for live firing. #3 Coming to and from the firing line you must have your firearm unloaded, completely clear of all ammunition and in a case or bag. (not a holster). The only exception to the rule is that regular Benchrest competitors may carry an uncased benchrest rifle to and from the firing line when that rifle is made safe and carried in a safe manner. The current #3 will move to #4 and so on.
