

**MINUTES OF THE RIFLE AND PISTOL RANGE
BOARD OF MANAGEMENT MEETING
APRIL 28, 2007**

Board members present: Freddy Haltom, Joe Basham, John Krenik and Bill Cooke.

Advisory board committee present: Gary Brednick, Bill Perry, Doug Fox, Brian Hendershot and Jeremy Jackson.

Members Present:

1. A report was given by Freddy on the emergency contact signs to be posted at the range, and on the lead contamination brochure that is made available to members during the range orientation.
2. A motion was made and passed to remove the buzzer system from Range D. The targets that were causing safety problems requiring the buzzer controlled from Range C, have been removed. New positions for the problem targets are being considered.
3. A motion was made and passed to fill the hole at the front of the concrete pad on Range D. Filling this hole will allow moving the firing line forward, creating a larger safe area on the concrete pad behind the firing line.
4. There was some discussion brought up on the problems and condition of the rifle range tractor. John Krenik shared the long range plan to pursue the purchase of a new tractor. New blades for the tractor/mower are on order and a few repairs in process.
5. A motion was made and passed to have a long range sight in day once a month on Range D. Freddy Haltom will be director of the project, with the intention of creating a new long range rifle discipline. The practice will be on a Sunday evening once a month at 6 pm.
6. A motion was made and passed to allow the High Power Match Director to establish the purchase of ammunition from Black Hills Co. to be ordered and sold to regular MSA rifle discipline competitors for use in their particular competitions.
7. In continuation of rule changes for the 07–08 membership year, **Change #1.** Rule #9 under safety rule for all ranges was moved to after #11 under General Rules. **Change #2.** A new line item under safety rules for all ranges is the second sentence of #14. The new line item should read, It is strongly suggested that you do not eat or drink while shooting and that you wash your hands immediately after shooting. (See Lead Contamination Brochure.) **Change #3.** Under General rules, #2, Remove (Beginning August 1. 2005.) **Change #4.** Under Range C rules, #2 should read, Shoot only at the existing targets. Re-set the targets only to their proper positions on the rails and do not walk over the berms behind the silhouette targets. **Change #5.** Remove line 7 from Range D rules. Cease firing when the buzzer sounds..... **Change #6.** Under guest policies, the last line should say (...living within the household.)
