

MSA R&P Minutes, 9/29/07

Attendees, Mike Conry, John Krenick, Joe Basham, Bill Cooke as directors and W.H. Pickering, Gary Long, Rick Pierce and Gaylene Stansbery as members.

John Krenick reported that the new storage building was very near completion, and that the contractor was owed \$6128.00 upon completion. He also noted that the building needed to be added to the insurance. John also Moved that \$2000.000 be allocated for wiring and work benches. Bill Cooke seconded. The motion passed.

Bill Cooke proposed a public rifle sight-in day and a turkey shoot, to be run by he and Gayleen Stansbery, with \$1000.00 max. seed money to be provided by the R&P account. Mike Conry so moved and the motion passed.

John Krenick moved, after some discussion, to approve a 40 rifle sight in for Show Of Support (Terry Johnson). Waiving all fees that may be incurred, making Diron Rotan tentative point man, at a date to be determined Joe Basham seconded. The motion carried.

John Krenick moved and Mike seconded a motion to incorporate the MSA highpower program into a league with the Pecos highpower program, to be called the Permian Basin Highpower League. Motion carried.

John Krenick moved and Joe Basham seconded, after some discussion, to allow Pick Pickering and Gayleen Stansbery to use the MSA clubhouse and ranges when available for NRA certification classes, Women on Target and Hunter Safety classes following all NRA rules and MSA procedures for non-members using the range, giving the instructor an exception allowing unloaded firearms in the clubhouse as teaching aids, with the instructor posting this during all classes where firearms are present. Motion passed.

Mike Conry asked Rick Pierce to determine the scope and cost of a fireproof safe for the purpose of storing of supplies pertaining to the electronic gate, and other items requiring safekeeping at the range, and report back to the Board.
