

Midland Shooters Association Rifle and Pistol Board meeting minutes for

November 12, 2011

Meeting was called to order by Mike Conry at 6:17 pm

Mike Conry read the minutes, John Krenik made a motion to accept the minutes, Kaye Mauldin seconded the motion, motion passed.

Old Business;

Discussion: DiAnn talked about the new forms to be used by CHL Instructors for special orientations and that not everyone was using them. John Krenik will talk to the other instructors about using the forms.

Discussion: John Krenik informed us that John Drissel is working on getting new signs for the ranges.

Discussion: Reis Ritz informed the board that he and Max Mauldin have been working on redoing the range rules. John Krenik asked that the board get together and go over them.

New Business;

Mark Merritt and Billy Callaway (who are both members) asked permission to use the range for CHL Classes. Kaye Mauldin volunteered to show both of them the target stands and paperwork used for CHL classes.

Kaye Mauldin made a motion to allow Mark Merritt and Billy Callaway to use the range for CHL Classes subject to coordinating the use of the clubhouse with Mike Conry. John Krenik seconded the motion, motion passed.

Deane Durham discussed that the Westerners Team shoot will be held on April 21st. Reis Ritz will get with Eric to get the dates on the website.

Mike Conry made a motion to allow Dean Durham to hold the Westerners Team Shoot and to close down ranges 0 through 9 and Ranges D & E from noon on April 20th through Monday April 23rd.

Discussion: John Krenik informed the board that the well runs all the time and that there is probably a leak underground.

Mike Conry made a motion to allow \$500.00 to get someone out to service the water well behind Range E to see what we need to do to fix it. Kaye Mauldin seconded the motion, motion passed.

Discussion: John Krenik discussed the fact that John Drissel has been working for MSA for 5 years without a raise. He currently makes \$1900.00 a month with a \$100.00 gas allowance. We discussed what amount of raise would be sufficient.

Mike Conry made a motion to adjust John Drissel's salary to \$2300.00 a month with a \$200.00 gas allowance effective December 1, 2011. Kaye Mauldin seconded the motion, motion passed.

Discussion: DiAnn Mehl suggested we put a sign up at the clubhouse of things that need to be done around the range for people who would like to volunteer.

Discussion: Mike Conry scheduled a paint day to paint the silhouette range on Saturday November 19th.

Discussion: Reis Ritz discussed the lead at the range and that we have been contacted by accompany that recovers lead and rebuilds the berms. The range could benefit from this by either a percent of the lead or they can do road, berm or dirt work in lieu of the money while he has the heavy machinery already at the range. It was decided to get references on them before deciding. This was tabled until references had been checked.

Discussion: John Krenik reminded the board that his Texas Border Volunteers will be doing their night vision exercises Friday night, November 18th at 7:30 pm. There will be no shooting involved.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:10 pm by Mike Conry.
